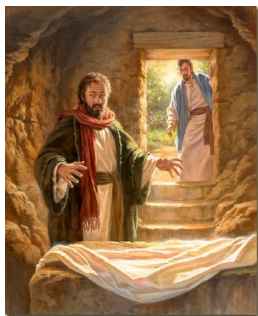

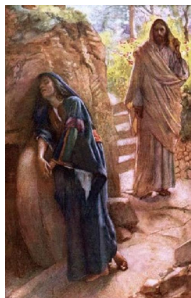

John 20:1,2 Mary Magdalene at empty tomb

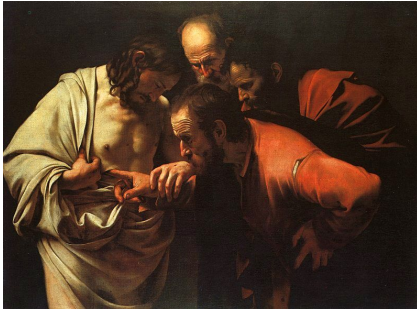


John 20:3-10 John and Peter at empty tomb

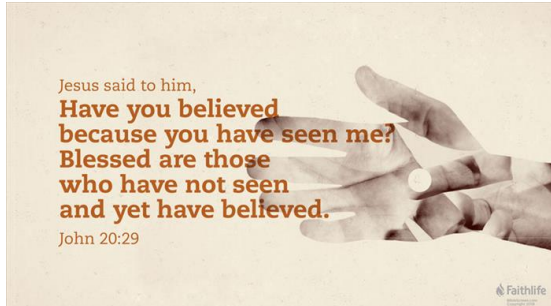




John 20:19-22 Apostles encounter
