District Educators Notes:

Members participating in the Rider Education Levels Program who have expired or will expire on or after January 1, 2020 are granted a grace period that has been extended until December 31, 2020 allowing time for the Member to take part in one or more of the following courses or classes to bring their level up to date: • GWRRA (or RE Program approved alternative) on-bike course • The University's Co-Rider seminar • GWRRA MEDIC FIRST AID® (or MFA Program approved alternative) class. The grace period will not be decreased and may be extended if deemed necessary.

Medic First Aid (MFA) First Aid / CPR Courses remain suspended for the time being. A survey of MFA Coordinators and District Educators on their willingness to present the courses under the Covid-19 Sanitation and disinfecting restrictions was submitted for questions and comments. HSI and MFA COVID-19 precautions will be labor intensive and time consuming, so we are proceeding at a slow pace to make sure we do this right!

GWRRA Rider Education is offering a Chapter Skill Enhancement Adviser (CSEA) ZOOM Training Session on June 24, 2020 at 8:00 pm. Training will introduce the CSEA to the Rider Education forms and procedures and give the CSEA a better understanding of their job requirements. A follow-up session will be presented at a later date. I sent a reminder to all the Chapter Skill Enhancement Advisors that I have on record with Confidentiality Agreements. It is not too late to appoint a new CSEA and have them participate in the training.

I'm including directions on how to check your Rider Levels Information on "My R.E." that Steve Cotton prepared a while back. Hope you will find it helpful.

I have received a few questions on the availability of Rider Courses now that Oklahoma has entered Phase III of reopening. OK District is working to re-schedule our Trike Rider Course in September or October and we will announce the date as soon as we confirm our range. We had a Oklahoma Highway Safe Riders Program Course planned for our September Rally and we will need at least 15 riders to sign up. We will need to confirm this is still available. I will include a list of Riding Courses accepted for GWRRA Levels with my Notes if you wish to locate a different Rider Course to fit your schedule.

That's all the news I have for now! Ride safe! Keep the shiny side up and we'll see you down the road!

How to Check Your Rider Levels Information

To check your Rider Education information:

1. Go to the GWRRA homepage: <http://www.gwrra.org>
2. Click the tab at the top: "Officers"
3. Click the tab that appears below Officers: "Rider Education"
4. On the page that appears, there is a column of links on the left, and about 8 tabs down – click "My R. E. Information"
5. Enter your Username and Password in the spaces provided (**Note example at the bottom of this page**), then click the "Submit" button
6. Find your name in the list that appears, and click "View" on the far right side
7. At the bottom of the page, click "All History" to see all your classes and records
8. Here you can see things such as your **TRC** (Trike Riders Course), **FA** (First Aid) and **CPR** (Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation) records – when taken and expiration dates.

LOGIN NOTE:

Username = your GWRRA Membership Number, i.e. 123456 or 123456-01

Password = Numbers in your house address and Membership Expiration Date (mmyy)

Password example: If your address is 12 West 6th Street, only the 12 would be used, followed by your membership expiration date (mmyy). If your membership expiration date is 01/15, then your password would be 120115.

Check your Membership card for your membership number and expiration date.

Microsoft Word Document: Checking My RE Information

If the course is listed as "Range Only" it may be used in the levels, but the next rider course must be a course listed as "Full Course". Oklahoma GWRRA,

It is good to see some chapters getting together even under this new “normal” that we are living in. It is amazing to see the “out of the box” thinking that many of our chapters are using to get together and still touch each other. Keep up the great work!

The district would like to offer a new challenge to all chapters during the month of July. There will be 8 online classes from the university during the month. Each class will be given twice making a total of 16 times you can be a part of a training class. This is the challenge/contest, and every chapter will have the same chance of winning. Sign up for the online class and receive one point towards the drawing at the end of the month for your chapter. Each chapter can only receive 2 points per class. If 8 people in your chapter would sign up for the same class at the same time slot you would receive 2 points towards the drawing. We will limit the numbers of points per chapter to 10 points for the month, that way we will keep it on the same level of chances to win for all chapters. One person could attend all 8 classes and a second person attend 2 classes and they would have their 10 chances filled. Or 2 people could attend 5 different classes that could be 10 points for your chapter. Remember only 2 points be given per class per chapter per session. The classes that are going to be given are:

If 2 people want to take the course on July 8 Mature Rider at 3 pm and then 2 other people from the same chapter take it at 6 pm the chapter would get 4 points. If they all took it at 3 pm the chapter would only get 2 points.

At our monthly meeting we will put all the chances that are available into a hat and the winning chapter will receive a \$50.00 gift certificate for Braums! Did anyone say ice cream??? 

May 2020 GWRRA Oklahoma District Participation & Ridership Summary

Since the first of the year, many Chapters have been participating in a process where Chapter activities and motorcycle ridership has been tracked. The intent is to create a planning and communications tool - and to share information and ideas for consideration and adoption to enhance the Membership experience among all Chapters. To date, this information has been shared only with District and Chapter Leadership. The following gives everyone a “Snapshot” look at activities across the District for the month of May.

Since the middle of March, normal Chapter activities have been significantly curtailed by mandatory “shelter in place” restrictions brought on by the Corona Virus outbreak. Many Chapter, District and National GWRRA events had to be canceled. But many have looked for and implemented new and innovative ways to keep Members informed, engaged, and entertained.

May has been a significant turnaround month for most Chapters. Many have been venturing out for limited in person group activities and rides - while also carrying on with virtual activities. It is good to see so many utilizing the Zoom Video conference service for a variety of activities. Also, it is good to see Chapters sharing and implementing ideas to keep their Members active, informed and engaged.
