



### CPS Finalizes Dist. Enrollment

Chicago Public Schools announced the official district wide enrollment, which is tallied based on the 20th day analysis, as well as increased funding rates for low-income pupils and schools with high levels of poverty.

Enrollment rates are as follows: system-wide CPS for school year 2015-16 (SY 15-16): 392,285 students; CPS-run K-12 schools: 303,198 and K-12 charter schools: 61,496.

The District's K-12 enrollment increased by 2,230 students since the 10th day of school.

Based on the enrollment numbers, CPS increased the per-pupil funding rates for federal Title I funds and Supplemental General State Aid, both of which are allocated to support low-income students and high poverty schools. The Title I rate increased by \$23.20 per qualifying pupil and the SGSA rate increased by \$7.40 per low-income pupil.

Early education opportunities continue to expand, with 28,349 children enrolled citywide in CPS programs or CPS-funded programs.

### IDPH Urges Flu Shots

Illinois Department of Public Health Director Nirav D. Shah, M.D., J.D. is recommending that everyone older than 6 months be vaccinated against influenza. The flu season in typically starts around October and can last up to May. ### State Rating of Schools



BY DR. R. PLETSCH

The Illinois State Board of Education has approved a new system it plans to use to rate schools and school districts. The only question that remains before full implementation is if the state needs approval from the US Department of Education because this rating system relies less on academics than the system they had earlier presented to the Department.

All schools and their communities like to talk about who has the best school system. This new rating system probably will not settle that situation. It may even lead to more arguments and settle very little. It is likely the real estate agents will interpret it to their advantage after all, many people say I'm moving because this school or that district is better. Around much of this area they look at how many kids from the school go to college and who has the highest Reading and Math scores, and little or no gang violence.. These results often are tied hand in hand with parents with higher incomes. This new rating system developed by Vision 20/20 only depends 30% on achievement tests (PARCC) and on graduation rates. The part open for discussion is that 70% depends on subjective matter like atmosphere, family involvement, and decision making. You can write books about these and not come to an agreement.
