ENTRY BLANKS: Must be sent to Ed Hanson, 130 Beacon Valley Rd., Beacon Falls, CT 06403 by Labor Day. No entries will be accepted after this date.

ENTRY TAGS: Will be attached to coops by committee.

EXHIBIT DELIVERY: To Poultry & Rabbit Barn **Thursday from 5 pm to 10 pm and Friday until 2 pm.** Enter through the South gate.

EXHIBIT REMOVAL: See General Rules, Livestock Exhibitors.

ENTRY FEES: ALL exhibitors must pay a \$10 entry fee for this department, plus a cooping fee of \$0.50 for each bird. Entry fee must accompany entry.

DEPARTMENT RULES

- Connecticut requirements: Poultry vaccinated within 30 days with a live virus vaccine will be prohibited from showing. Poultry must come from healthy flocks with no evidence of contagious or infectious disease.
- 2. No substitute birds.
- 3. Connecticut residents will be given first preference for entries due to space limitations.
- 4. Single entries only. No trios or pairs will be accepted.
- 5. Judging on first three only.
- 6. Entries will be accepted on Standard Breed birds only. No Crosses.
- 7. The Bethlehem Fair is not responsible for any accident, mistake, loss or damage from any cause.
- 8. The Judge's decision is final.
- 9. Judging to be at 3 pm Friday.
- 10. Feed and water will be furnished by the Fair.
- 11. Exhibits must remain until 5:30 pm Sunday.
- 12. Judges will be instructed to withhold a prize when, in their opinion, the specimen is not of sufficient merit.
- 13. No appeal from the decision of the Judges will be considered upon any ground whatsoever. Exhibitors will indicate on entry blanks all standard birds as "S" and bantams as "B."
- 14. All birds exhibited must be at least five months of age and from flocks participating in the official Pulloram eradication program. Exhibitor must have a card of approval from the Livestock Division, indicating that the birds were negative to a Pulloram Test within 12 months.
- 15. No entries will be accepted over the phone.
