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Skeptics argue that the United States is irreparably divided by ideological conflict—yet our national history proves that America <u>always</u> answers the call to close gaps and bridge the divide. In so doing, we emerge a victorious and more perfect union.

The 3-Point Plan to Unite America is a call for elected officials to act with speed, precision, and

courage to save our country. Politically conservative beliefs and Republicanism have been a longtime practice of American Freedmen (descendants of slaves with 3-to-20+ generations vested in the U.S.). In our 2022 Twitter straw poll (n=276), 85% of Freedmen reported openness to voting Republican—given an All Americans First agenda that includes Freedmen priorities. Freedmen comprise ~80% of America's Black population. The Plan highlights action priorities from the multigenerational Black American perspective on THREE [3] critical areas to improve the stability, security, and quality-of-life for descendants of freed foundational Americans and the country that is our home. Now, as before, multigenerational Black American conservatism is rooted in patriotism, the unity of States, preservation of national character, the full implementation and enforcement of unalienable rights and the constitutional protections that our nation's Founders and subsequent countrymen fought to secure. Stand with us.

Law & Order + Responsibility & Accountability

Our children and families will live in communities that are safe, stable, and secure—where exercise of legitimate authority is respected and honorable. To preserve the dignity, well-being, and life of citizens and first responders, we will fund public safety and community mental health services. We will implement processes to meaningfully track impacts and accountability for providers of public safety and mental health services.

An Americanizing Education



Our children will experience an education that is fair, resourced, and right for them. They will discover the significance of our Flag and learn how to live a life steeped in allegiance to the United States of America—rooted in the words of our founding documents, sacred principles, and the course of human events that drive the evolution of our complex history.

All Americans First



Our government exists to protect and serve the rights and resources of its citizenry and, when needed, to provide and distribute national resources to ensure economic stability and security in our homeland. We will implement

plans for sourcing labor of American citizens at competitive wages, across industries, for multiple generations. We

will also decrease the number of migrants by limiting legal and illegal immigration.

Law & Order + Responsibility & Accountability

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CALLS TO ACTION:

- Fund law enforcement training to include trauma-informed practices, de-escalation strategies, non-physical interventions, quota-free systems of engagement, and analysis of human impact.
- Fund and incentivize embedment of Crisis Intervention Teams (CIT) in law enforcement units.
- Fund and incentivize implementation of community health worker programs that collaborate with law enforcement during wellness checks and situations potentially involving mental health crises and/or calls related to social care.
- Fund programs in law enforcement departments that establish best practices regarding officers in need of and/or seeking mental health supports without unduly endangering officer livelihood yet ensuring wellness and certifying fit for duty.
- Identify and quickly course correct personnel-related and institutional safety issues. Require institutions that receive federal funds, technical assistance, support and/or equipment to implement written performance improvement and quality assurance measures and to record, monitor, and report findings related to use of force and delivery of equal justice in community-based law enforcement encounters, pre-trial detentions, and post-sentencing incarceration.

An Americanizing Education

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- Reinvigorate the telling of a full history of the United States. Textbooks will amplify the courage inherent in our national trajectory. By conveying age-appropriate context about the stakeholders and factors that drive the evolution of our nation—the triumphs, the errors, the hurts, and the healing—the next generation of Americans may appreciate our past while building upon the solid and complex foundation of the United States.
- Secure the sacred place of American Freedmen (multigenerational Black American) History by calling for its continued and specific inclusion in PreK-16 course materials and curricula.
- Notice attempts and prevent the Left and other interest groups from "legitimizing" their political agendas and identity politics that appropriate the contributions of American Freedmen. Ensure the full representation of antecedent and domestic American Freedmen history in PreK-12 curricula.
- Fund competent, skilled, and credentialed professional development for school districts that aim to train staff about recognizing biases and undoing negative racial impacts. While everyone has a race and should be able to speak about their own experiences and empathize with the experiences of others, it takes professional skill, structure, processes, and preparation to properly lead professional trainings that challenge existing paradigms, support personal/institutional responsibility, and facilitate problem solving—rather than mere blaming or shaming.

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All Americans First

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CALLS TO ACTION:

- Mandate use of e-verify for all employers, regardless of size and industry.
- Develop, implement, monitor impacts, and report on a multigenerational plan for recruitment and retention of Americans in labor sourcing, across industries.
- Relaunch the Freedmen's Bureau—solely to the descendants of U.S. slaves—to quickly distribute repair of the slave-lineage wealth gap, streamline monitoring of impacts on lineage-specific employment, investment, and business development to stabilize Freedmen households, families, and legacy communities. Create a census category for "American Freedmen."
- Decrease the numbers of future legal immigrants and decrease tolerance of illegal migration.
- Disband and defund the Office of New Americans and sanctuary cities.
- Limit family migration to include only members of a nuclear family.
- Charge unauthorized usage fees to home countries and individuals at two instances of illegal border crossing and/or
- Limit migrant allotments for countries with repeat offenses of visa overstays and/or illegal crossings.
- Implement avoidance-proof entry and exit systems for visitors and migrants.

visa overstays. Bar overstayers and illegal crossers from future applications.
