1.	Women's Skillet Throw	Throw a skillet the farthest within boundaries. Age 18 and over. The winner is eligible and invited to enter the Litchfield County Council of Fairs Contest at the Riverton Fair on Sunday, October 15, 2023.	\$25	\$15	\$10
2.	Hay Bale Throwing	Throw a 35-40-lb bale the farthest without breaking and while staying within the boundaries. Broken bales disqualify.	\$25	\$15	\$10
3.	Egg Toss (Partners)	Two lines keep tossing until the egg breaks, taking a step back after each toss. <b>Partners must be in the same age group.</b>	\$50	\$30	\$20
