

“The Gift of the Holy Spirit” is a Promise From God To You!

Chapter 5

When a person is, through the Gospel, convicted by the Holy Spirit to turn from sin and convinced by the Holy Spirit to turn to God, and is then baptized (born of water and the Spirit), he/she receives “the gift of the Holy Spirit.”

Acts chapter 2 states this:

“Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Men and brethren, what shall we do?” Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.” Acts 2:37



In Acts 2:39 we learn that “the gift of the Holy Spirit” was/is a promise from God: "For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call."

Ephesians 1:13 refers to new Christians receiving this promise: “In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise.”



Here are some other Scriptures that mention God giving “the gift of the Holy Spirit” to His newborn children:

“And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him.” Acts 5:32

“And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, “Abba, Father!” Galatian 4:6

“Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.” 1 John 3:24

“. . . God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us. By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.” 1 John 4:12,13



“Now He who establishes us with you in Christ . . . who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee. 2 Corinthians 1:21,22
