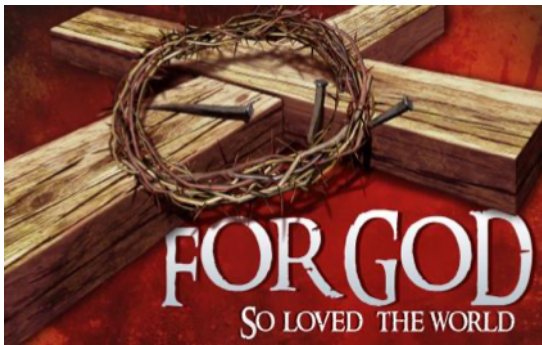

# John's Testimony Tells Us Why!

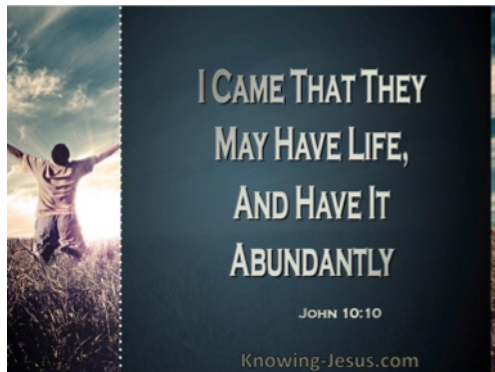
John 21:24

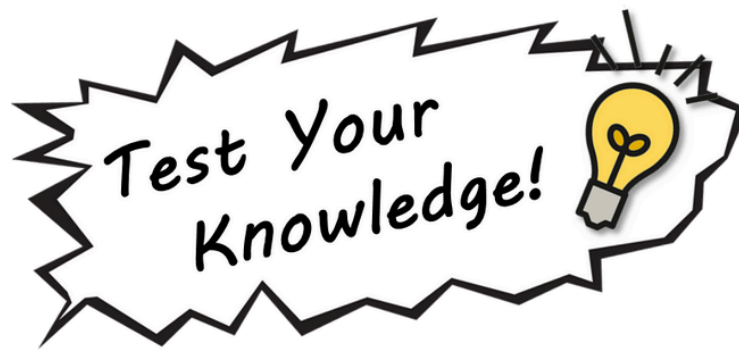
