**Ape Weekend At Brookfield Zoo**



Brookfield Zoo will conduct Ape Awareness Weekend on Saturday, April 11th, from 10a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Sunday, April 12th, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The animal care staff will host special zoo chats on Tropic World highlighting the three ape species and other primates. From 10 a.m. to noon, guests can see one-year-old orangutan Kecil with his surrogate mother, Maggie, and then learn about them and

other orangutans during a chat at noon.

The zoo's family of five white-cheeked gibbons will be featured at 1 p.m. At 2 p.m., zoogoers can find out about some of the other primate species that reside in Tropic World's South America habitat. Nora, the one-year-old western lowland gorilla and her family of three generations, will be the focus of a 2:45 p.m. chat in Tropic World: Africa.

Primate keepers and zoo volunteers will share information and artifacts and answer questions about individual apes, primate conservation, and the care provided. Before visiting the zoo, youngsters can download fun activity sheets at [www.CZS.org/Events](http://www.CZS.org/Events) to learn more about gibbons and orangutans.

Guests are invited to help save the apes' wild habitat by recycling their old cell phones and other electronics. Mining for coltan, a mineral widely used in cell phones, is threatening the habitat of gorillas and other forest species in the Democratic Republic of Congo. The Chicago Zoological Society will collect old cell phones, accessories, pagers, handheld games, e-readers, and laptops at recycling stations, located at the North and South Gates.

Activities during the weekend are free with general zoo admission of \$16.95 for adults, \$11.95 for children 3-11 and for seniors 65 and over. Children 2 and under are free. Parking is \$10. For further information, call (708) 688-8000.

**Warning For Canine Flu**

The Chicago Veterinary Medical Association recommends dog owners take immediate measures to prevent their dogs from exposure to Canine Infectious Respiratory Disease.

Information to date suggests that the canine influenza virus may be the primary causative agent associated with the increased number of severe respiratory cases currently being seen by Chicago area veterinarians.

Due to the contagious nature of the canine influenza virus, all dogs are at serious risk of infection when exposed to this virus. Even dogs exhibiting no signs of illness can be contagious, asymptomatic carriers to other dogs.

Pet owners should contact their veterinarian immediately if they see any of the following symptoms in their dog(s): persistent, hacking cough, lethargic behavior, a poor appetite, nasal discharge, trouble breathing, or a fever. Testing for canine influenza is available, and best results are obtained from samples taken very early in the onset of the illness. Sick dogs should be isolated from other animals.

Due to the high risk of canine influenza virus spreading from dog to dog, pet owners should not allow their dogs to either socialize with other dogs or participate in any group dog training activities. Pet owners are advised to not board their dogs at kennels and to avoid doggie day care, dog parks, and grooming facilities at this time.

In addition to the canine influenza virus being transmitted directly from dog to dog, the virus can live on hard surfaces and fabric materials making these items contaminated as well.

To help minimize the spread of disease, it is also crucial that everyone should observe basic sanitation protocols, such as washing hands after touching animals or handling any items like food bowls, water bowls, toys, crates, and cages. These items should also be thoroughly cleaned.

**Honor Flight Invites Veterans**



### Painting Depicts Armenian Genocide

To mark the 100th anniversary of the Armenian Genocide and the death and displacement of millions of Armenians, a descendant of the survivors has created an enormous work of art to both honor the victims and survivors and to celebrate the enduring strength and culture of the Armenian people.

Chicago artist Jackie Kazarian has titled the piece "Armenia" in the same dimensions (11.5 X 26 feet) as Pablo Picasso's famous painting *Guernica*.

Armenia (*Hayasdan*) is the culmination of two years of historical research and a lifetime of memories for Kazarian, whose grandparents fled their birthplace in historic Armenia, now part of Turkey, before World War I and emigrated to the United States.
